Pathways

You **must** have a pathway to graduate!

1. Earn you high school diploma
1. Be involved in a club, sport, or have a job
 - a. Show your counselor proof of this!
2. Show proof of college and career readiness
 - a. Earn an honors diploma, attend C9 and complete a program with a C or higher, ASVAB, complete an Indian Creek pathway

7 Semester Graduation

- ★ Application deadline, January 27th
- ★ Completion of all credits for a Core 40 diploma or higher
- ★ Have met graduation pathway
- ★ Completion of a 7 seven semester graduation application
- ★ Completion of a letter of rationale for the need for mid-term graduation
- ★ Since English 12 is a full year course, students will be required to take English second semester during the summer and first semester in the classroom. If a student does not complete this requirement, he/she will be ineligible to be a seven semester graduate.
- ★ One or more of the criteria may be waived at administrator discretion or through case conference committee decision

Scheduling Process

- ★ Watch this video!
- ★ Complete your course requests sheet
- ★ Schedule a time to meet with your counselor
- ★ Ask your counselor any questions you may have.
- ★ Keep a copy of your course requests for your records.

Timeline

- ★ Request courses: Meeting with your counselor before December 9th to choose your courses.
 - ★ 7 Semester Graduation Apps: January 27th
 - ★ C9 Applications: Feb 24
 - ★ Course Request Changes: May 1st
- These deadlines are important. There will be no exceptions.

Central 9

- Must be on track to graduate to attend C9
- Online Enrollment Form
- If you complete an application, you have committed to attend C9
- We do not allow students to drop any class, including C9, after May 1st.

Scheduling Tips

- 7 Sem Grads should choose a full year schedule
- Summer School-Credit Recovery and audits for honors diplomas if needed
- List a minimum of 4 alternates (if you do not pick them we will pick them for you and you will be permanently placed in what we choose)
- Check prerequisites
- Check diploma requirements
- Check out the Curriculum Guide for course descriptions

What to do before senior year

- Take the SAT/ ACT if you are planning on attending college
- Visit colleges
- You will be applying the fall of your senior year! Most colleges require you apply by November 1st
- Look for scholarships
- Explore the military if you are interested
