 - b. Reach ASVAB benchmark score of 31 or higher
 - c. Attending C9 and complete a 2 year program and earn a C- or higher.
 - d. Complete a pathway at Indian Creek high school and earn a C- or higher

Choosing Courses

- ★ C9 application can be filled out with your counselor.
- ★ You will request the rest of your courses
- ★ Consider diploma requirements
 - Failed, required courses must be **retaken**
- ★ Consider college admission requirements
- ★ Consider job preparation

6 Semester Graduation

- ★ Application deadline: Friday, February 25th.
- ★ Completion of all credits for a Core 40 or Core 40 with honors diploma
- ★ Meet the requirements for a graduation pathway
- ★ Completion of a six semester graduation application
- ★ Completion of a typed essay of rationale on why it is important to graduate early (1-2 pages in length)
- ★ English 11 should be taken over the summer and English 12 must be taken in the classroom. To take English 11 in the classroom in addition to English 12, teacher approval must be obtained.
- ★ One or more of the criteria may be waived at administrator discretion or through case conference committee decision
- ★ The School Board will approve or deny all six semester graduation applications once administrator approval has been given

Timeline

- ★ Request courses: begin Wednesday, January 12th.
- ★ Email your counselor and set up an individual meeting between Wednesday, January 12th - Friday, January 28th
- ★ 6 Semester Graduation Apps: Friday, February 25
- ★ C9 Applications: Feb 25th
- ★ Course Request Changes: May 1st
 - Requests approved by availability

→ These deadlines are important.

Central 9

- Must be on track to graduate to attend C9
- Online Enrollment Form filled out with counselor in individual meeting
- If you complete an application, you have committed to attend C9.
- We do not allow students to drop any class, including C9, after May 1st.
