## **BIOGRAPHY**

State Sen. Jack E. Sandlin has represented Hoosiers in central Indiana since his election to the State Senate in 2016. Sandlin represents Senate District 36, which includes portions of Johnson and Marion counties.

He is a member of the Senate Committee on Corrections and Criminal Law; Environmental Affairs; and Insurance and Financial Institutions.

Prior to his election, Sandlin served on the Indianapolis City-County Council from 2010-2016 and was a Perry Township trustee from 1997-2006. He also served on the Indianapolis Police Department from 1973-1993 and the Southport Police Department from 1995-2009.

He is a fraud examiner and president of JS Consulting, Inc. He holds degrees from the University of Indianapolis and Indiana Wesleyan University.

Sandlin is on the Board of Directors for Central Indiana Youth for Christ, as well as the Perry Township Historical Society. He is also a member of the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 86, American Legion Post 56 and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1120.

He and his wife, Lydia, reside in Indianapolis and have one daughter and three grandchildren.
