

STICKS

- ice cube tray
- bathroom cup
- small plastic containers
- strawberry yogurt
- grape blackberry
- cookies n' cream

with aluminum

foil

- popsicle sticks
- spoons
- straws
- toothpicks (cut sharp ends)

Freeze for 6-8 hours, release, enjoy!

Strawberry - Yogurt

- 1 cup strawberries, cleaned, hulled, and sliced
- 1 cup vanilla yogurt
- 1. blend or puree strawberries
- z. spoon the strawberries and yogur into the molds in alternating layers


Grape - Blackberry

- 2 cups blackberries, cleaned
- 2 cup red seedless grapes, cleaned and halved
- 1. blend blackberries and grapes in a blender or food processor, run through sieve, squeezing out all the juice
- 2. pour juice into molds

Cookies n' Cream

vanilla ice cream, softened chocolate sandwich cookies, whole and crushed

- fill molds with ice cream and insert whole cookies, freeze
- remove frozen pops from molds and roll in crushed cookie crumbs to cover







TORNADO IN A JAR

GATHER:

- Container (cleaned glass jar or water bottle)
- Water
- Dish Soan
- Optional Pieces (glitter, hot glue gun)

STEP 1:

Fill container with water

STEP 2:

Squirt in dish soap

STEP 3:

OPTIONAL

• Add glitter

• Glue cap shut

STEP 4:

Rotate Container

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

Friction. As you twist the jar, the water inside up against the glass is pulled along due to its friction against the glass walls. The fluid toward the inside takes longer to get moving. But eventually both the glass jar and the fluid are spinning as you rotate the jar. When you stop rotating the jar, the fluid inside keeps spinning. A mini twister can be seen!

- lists


SEALING

LIST IDEAS


