Dear Junior Class Parents and Guardians;

All juniors in the state of Indiana are required to take the SAT per the Indiana Department of Education's plan for high school accountability. The SAT assesses high school mathematics, reading, and writing standards in grade 11. In addition to being the test used for Indiana High School accountability, the SAT is also a state graduation requirement for all students. This year, all juniors will take the SAT on **March 6**, **2024**. It is important that all juniors attend school that day and participate in SAT testing.

Please review some important information about the plan for testing day.

- It is very important that all juniors are in their testing rooms and ready to begin **NO LATER than 8:10 a.m.** The students will go immediately to their testing rooms upon entering the building. SAT and the College Board do not allow students to enter a room after testing has begun; therefore, it is very important that they are not late.
- It is also very important that students show up with a charged Chromebook. It may be difficult to get them charged that day during testing, so please remind them to charge it the night before so there are no disruptions to testing.
- Students are not allowed to have any electronic devices during testing. This includes cell phones, headphones, earbuds, or other wearable technology. We suggest they leave the electronics at home. If they bring their devices to school, they *must be turned off and placed in a book bag*. The teacher in the room will also be willing to collect them and hold on to them until testing is finished. This includes all breaks. Students are not to have electronic devices for the duration of the testing period. This means devices are powered off and inaccessible once testing begins until they are dismissed from the testing room after the final test. *Violating this rule could invalidate the test for all students in the room.* The student violating this rule will be suspended from school.
