
Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?




2. Should a person be required to pay a fee and undergo a background check in order to get a permit to carry a handgun in public?




3. Should local governments be able to restrict homeowners from renting out their property with short-term rental services like Airbnb?




Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health-care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?
