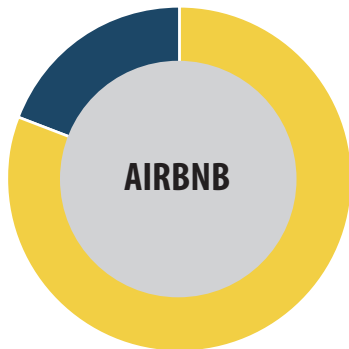
2. Should a person be required to pay a fee and undergo a background check in order to get a permit to carry a handgun in public?

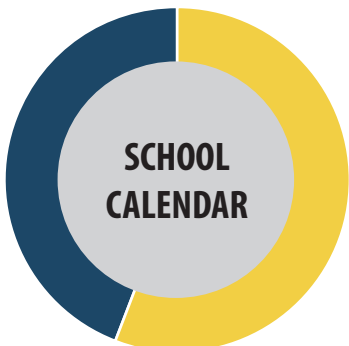
4. Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health-care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?

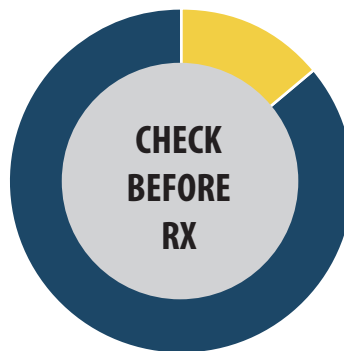
