## DELTA TAU DELTA CODE OF ETHICS FOR VOLUNTEERS Revised Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup> 2025

All Volunteers of Delta Tau Delta Fraternity shall adhere to and advocate the following principles and responsibilities:

To the best of my knowledge and ability, I pledge to:

- I. Act with honesty and integrity in the discharge of my duties and responsibilities as an appointed or elected volunteer.
- II. Abstain from actual or apparent conflicts of interest with the Fraternity, in all personal and professional relationships, including in execution of assigned roles/duties.
- III. Refrain from taking advantage of the trust of those with whom I work, whether they are undergraduates, fraternal organizations, community coalitions, or academic institutions, for personal or professional reasons.
- IV. Members should exercise discretion and professionalism in all online communications, ensuring that their social media activity reflects positively on the organization and adheres to the ethical standards outlined in this Code.
- V. Communicate with the Arch Chapter, Central Office, and duly appointed volunteers in a manner that is accurate, complete, objective, relevant, timely, and understandable.
- VI. Support, promote, and communicate the initiatives, campaigns, and programs as directed by the Arch Chapter and CEO of Delta Tau Delta Fraternity.
- VII. Comply with the rules and regulations of (a) federal, state, provincial, and local governments; (b) other private and public regulatory agencies; and (c) the Fraternity's host institutions, as they pertain to my activities on behalf of the Fraternity.
- VIII. Honor and obey those statutes of the Constitution and bylaws as written that pertain to my role as a volunteer including:
  - i. Not engaging in conduct that would embarrass the organization or bring discredit to its name;
  - ii. Uphold the confidentiality of information acquired in the course of my duties and to safeguard the secrets and mysteries of our *Ritual* and ceremonies;
  - iii. Be personally accountable for adherence to this Code of Ethics.

- IX. Model behavior consistent with the *Mission and Values* of the Fraternity to undergraduate and lifelong members alike with mature, thoughtful, and responsible behavior in all activities.
- X. Be accountable to the Fraternity for adhering to this Code of Ethics, I vow to support and uphold these principles.

Failure to faithfully observe the code as outlined may lead to dismissal from volunteer roles without reconsideration.**
