Get Your Flu Shot and More at the Library
Franciscan Health Offering Walk-in Clinics at JCPL

FRANKLIN, Ind. – Franciscan Health is offering flu shots and vaccines during walk-in clinics in October.

The Franciscan Health Immunization department wants everyone to get vaccinated against the flu or pneumonia. Clinics are on a first come, first served basis.

Clinics will be held at the following times and locations:

White River Branch – Oct. 6 from 9 a.m. to noon
Trafalgar Branch – Oct. 13 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
Clark Pleasant Branch – Oct. 15 from 9 to 10:30 a.m.
Franklin Branch – Oct. 22 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Some paper work will be required and then you may get your vaccination of choice. Vaccinations include: Flu Shots, High Dose Flu Shots, Pneumonia Shots, Prevnar, Tdap, Hep A, Hep B, Shingles Hep A and Hep B combined shot.

Immunizations are available to people six months and older. It is highly recommended that all individuals get a flu shot annually. The pneumonia immunization is recommended for individuals who have frequent upper respiratory infections or chronic medical conditions.
