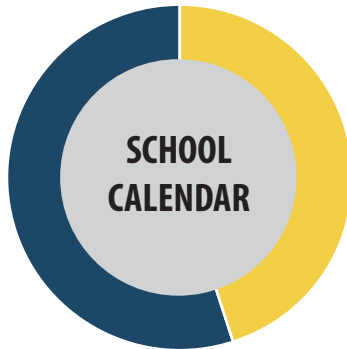
3. In order to limit prescription drug abuse, should doctors be required to check a patient's prescription history before issuing a new prescription?

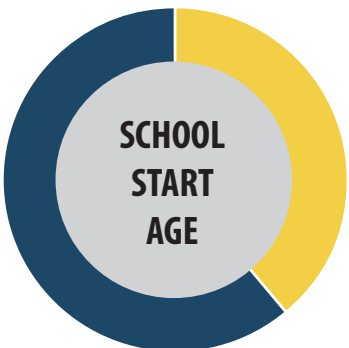
4. Indiana schools currently set their own calendars. Should schools be prohibited from starting classes before the last Monday in August?

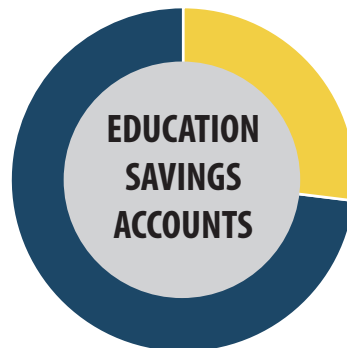
5. Current Indiana law requires a child's education to begin by age 7. Do you support or oppose changing the law so that a child's education must begin by age 5?

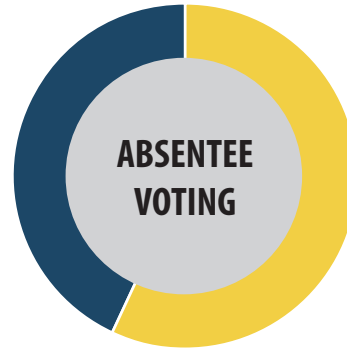
