Contest Dates:

Artwork may be submitted Nov. 2 – Dec. 1, 2019, by 5 p.m. The top three winners in each age category (grades 6-9 and grades 10-12) will win a prize. Winners will be announced in January. Members of the Creative Council of Franklin, Indiana, will judge artwork.

Teen Art Contest Reception:

All submissions will be on display at our Franklin Branch from 2-4 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 11, 2020, for the Teen Art Contest Reception. All artists are invited to attend to showcase their submissions and the general public is invited to meet the artists and view the work.

Artwork Pickup Information:

Artwork may be picked up at the Teen Art Contest Reception Saturday, Jan. 11, 2020, from 2 p.m. - 4 p.m. If you are unable to attend, please call Kelly Staten at the Franklin Branch to arrange a date/time for pickup. Submissions will be held for three months and then the library has the right to discard if artwork is not picked up by then.
