1. Develop a name and brand
2. Create a communications plan

4. Develop a platform (e.g., webpage, portal, etc.) for families
5. Provide support for 5 unlicensed programs
6. Assist 5 existing programs in expanding to serve infants/toddlers
7. Identify/support new early childhood education programs
8. Explore swing shift models/options to meet the local workforce needs
9. Increase number of high-quality programs
10. Create a resource fund to help programs reach PTQ
11. Increase number of staff credentials or degree
12. Partner with local school corporations and Ivy Tech
13. Assist programs in researching how to improve wages
14. Assist programs and schools to set Kindergarten readiness standards
15. Establish county-wide Kindergarten readiness assessment
16. Promote the use of dependent care accounts offered by employers
17. Promote the availability of publicly funded child care programs
