

CONFIDENTIALITY OF PATRON RECORDS AND LIBRARY RECORDS

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 5-14-3-4 provides that library records which can be used to identify any library patron are excepted from the public record disclosures requirement at the discretion of a public agency having jurisdiction over the records,

AND WHEREAS, Indiana Code 5-14-3-4 provides that library records which are deposited with, or acquired by, a library upon a condition that the records be disclosed only: to qualified researchers; after the passing of a period of years that is specified in the documents under which the deposit or acquisition is made; or after the death of persons specified at the time of the acquisition or deposit, are excepted from the public record disclosures requirement at the discretion of a public agency having jurisdiction over the records,

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Franklin – Johnson County Public Library wishes to protect the privacy and confidential records of its patrons,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that library records which can be used to identify any library patron are confidential and are not available for public access,

AND BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that library records which are deposited with, or acquired by, the library upon a condition that the records be disclosed only: to qualified researchers; after the passing of a period of years that is specified in the documents under which the deposit or acquisition is made; or after the death of persons specified at the time of the acquisition or deposit, are confidential and are not available for public access,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that nothing prohibits the library from using any of the aforementioned records for its own purposes and needs.
