Pathways

You **must** have a pathway to graduate!

- 1. Earn your high school diploma
- 2. Be involved in a club, sport, or have a job
 - a. Show your counselor proof of this!
- 3. Show proof of college and career readiness
 - a. Earn an honors diploma, attend C9 and complete a program with a C or higher, earn the SAT cut scores for EBRW & Math, earn a C average or higher in at least 3 AP/Dual Credit courses or complete an Indian Creek pathway*.

^{*}Indian Creek pathways include Agriculture, Education, Fashion, Computer Science, Band, Art, Choir, Interior Design, Business, and Advanced Manufacturing.

Career Exploration Updates

- Due to the changes in the schedule for next year (8 period day), students will be required to attend their career exploration/capstone placement periods 5-8.
- This means students will only take 4 ICHS courses.
- Example schedule:
 - M, T, F periods 1-4 then leave at 11:35 AM
 - W periods 2 and 4 then leave at 11:00 AM
 - TH periods 1, 3, and IRP then leave at 12:05 PM

**Students must complete an application in order to be considered for career exploration and capstone courses.

Empower Requirements

- GPA requirement is a 2.7
- MANDATORY student and parent meeting at the end of the 24-25 school year for all students in ALL empower courses for the 25-26 school year. If you do not attend, you will be removed from empower courses.
- No more than 10 unexcused absences in the 24-25 school year.
- MUST fill out an application in order to be considered.
- If you have an F in your empower course you must schedule a meeting with your teacher and counselor. You will also not be able to leave for the ENTIRE week if you have an F in the course.
- Disciplinary action will be taken if you have and F and leave the school building.
- Students are able to take only ONE empower course. Two empower courses can be considered if there is teacher approval from both empower teachers.
- If a student fails the first semester of an empower course, they will automatically be withdrawn from the second semester of a course.
- If a student is failing within the first 2 weeks of a course (within the drop deadline) they will automatically be removed from the course.
- Juniors and seniors ONLY
- ALL courses will be capped at 25 students. Once empower is at the 25 student limit, no one else will be added to the course.

7 Semester Graduation

- ★ Application deadline, March 1st
- ★ Completion of all credits for a Core 40 diploma or higher
- ★ Have met graduation pathway
- ★ Completion of a 7 seven semester graduation application
- ★ Since English 12 is a full year course, students will be required to take English second semester during the summer and first semester in the classroom. If a student does not complete this requirement, he/she will be ineligible to be a 7 semester graduate.
- ★ One or more of the criteria may be waived at administrator discretion or through case conference committee decision.

Central 9

- Must be on track to graduate to attend C9
- Online Application Required
 - You are responsible for filling out the application. If you do not fill it out, you will NOT be considered for the program.
- If you are accepted into the C9 program of your choice, you are committed to the program for the full year.
- We do not allow students to drop any class, including C9, after May 1st.

Timeline

- ★ Request courses: Meeting with your counselor by December 13th to choose your courses.
- ★ 7 Semester Grad Apps: March 1, 2025
- ★ C9 Applications: January 31, 2025
- ★ Course Request Changes: May 1st
 - \rightarrow These deadlines are important. There will be no exceptions.
