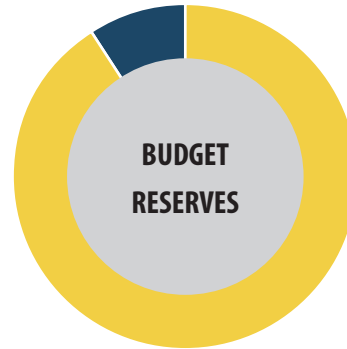

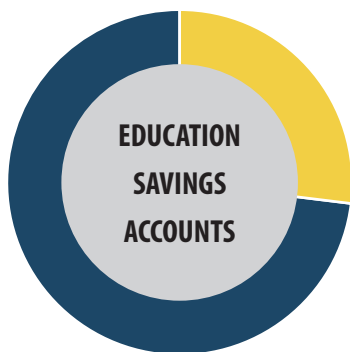

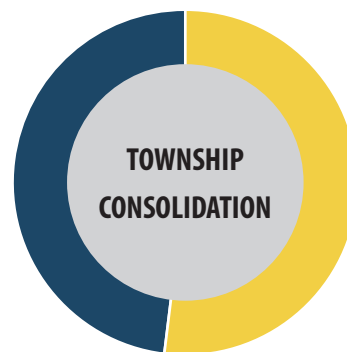

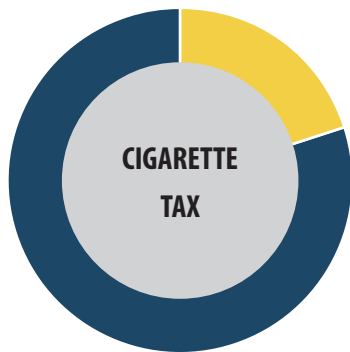

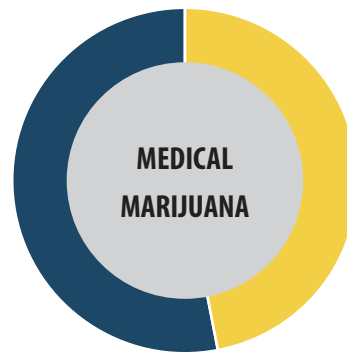
- 5.** Do you support or oppose raising Indiana's cigarette tax by \$1.50 per pack in order to deter smoking and pay for health programs?

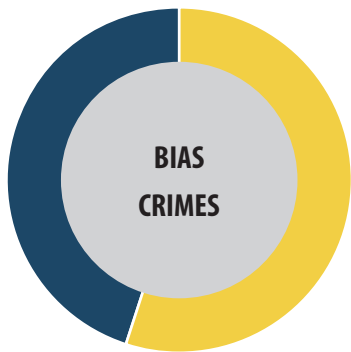
- 6.** Should Indiana legalize marijuana for medical use?
