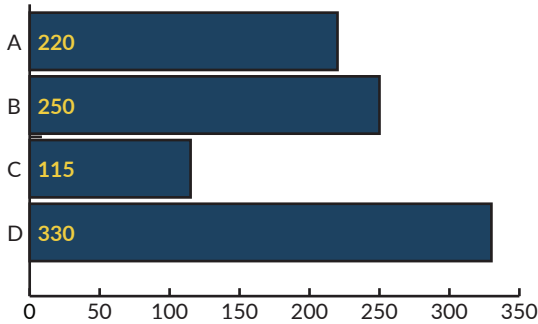

BUDGET SURPLUS

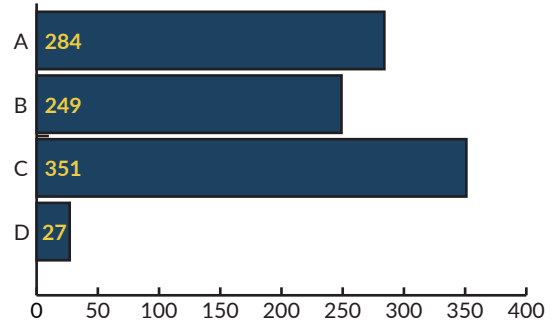

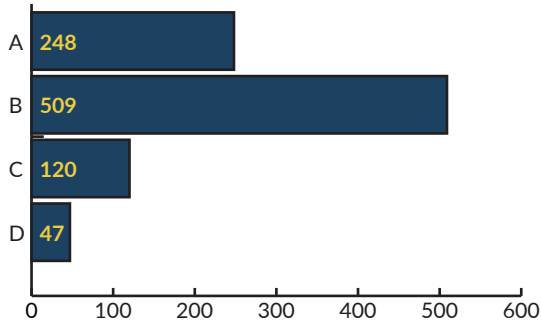

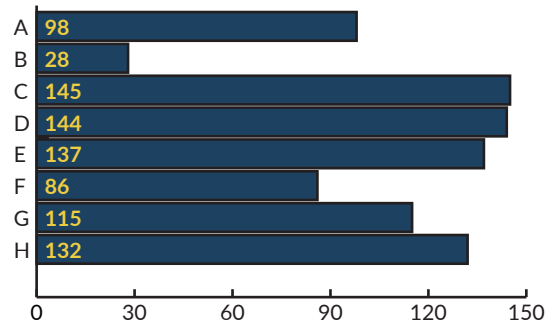

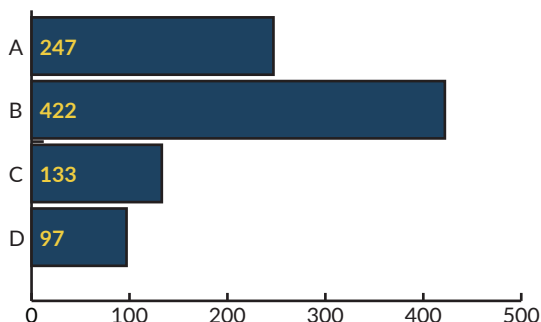

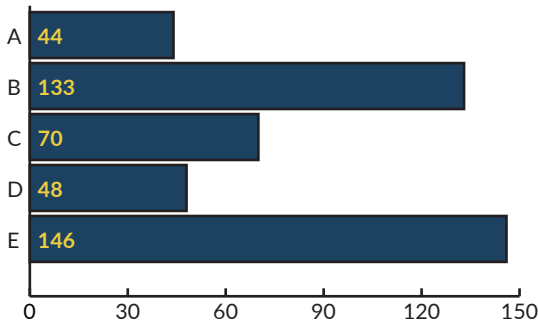

ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH CARE

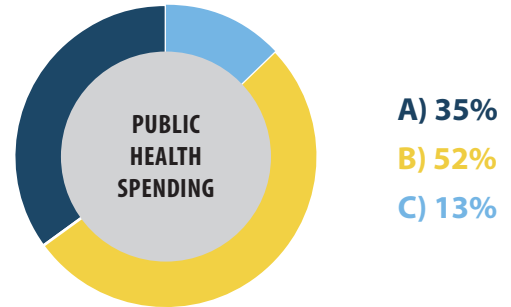

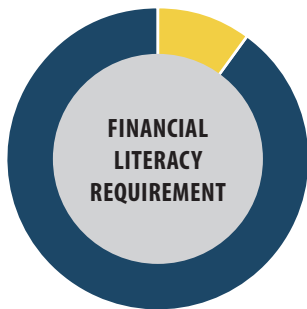
7. Which of the following reflects your opinion on public health spending in Indiana?

8. Should Indiana require high school students to take a financial literacy course covering topics such as setting a personal budget and long-term saving?



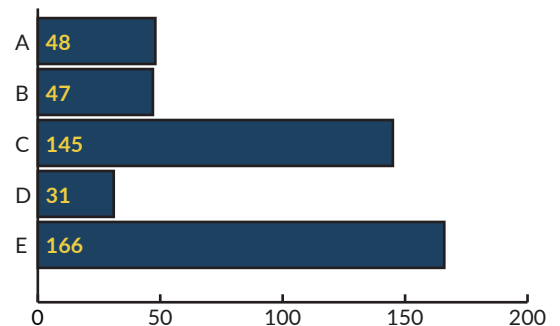
