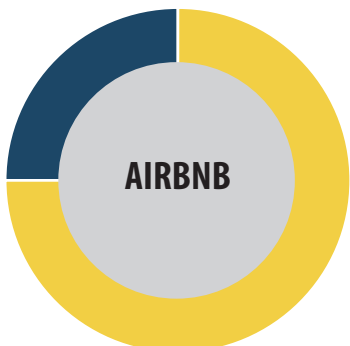
4. Should a person be required to pay a fee and undergo a background check in order to get a permit to carry a handgun in public?

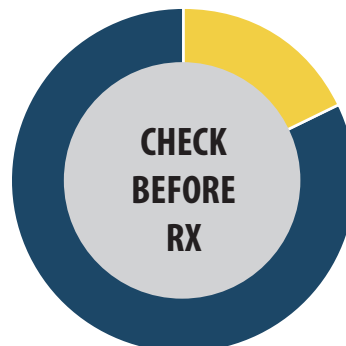
5. Should local governments be able to restrict homeowners from renting out their property with short-term rental services like Airbnb?

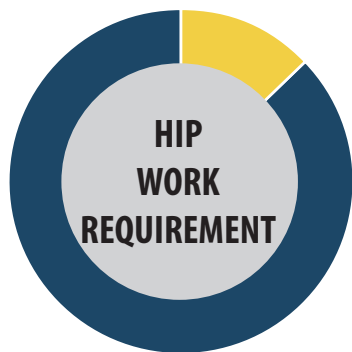

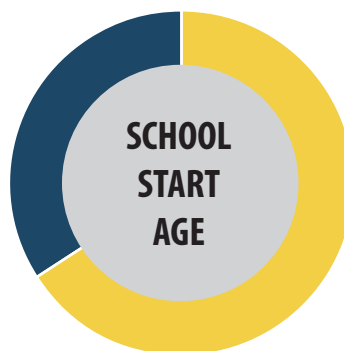
