






OPEN THE GOOGLE CLASSROOM APP OR GO TO CLASSROOM.GOOGLE.COM

Your student's account should already be logged into the Google Classroom app on their school issued iPad




If you are using a computer and going to the website, you will need to login to Classroom with your student's school email and password



CHOOSE YOUR COURSE


Click on the course you want to view and work in

App view




NAVIGATING IN YOUR COURSES (APP VIEW)


