COLLABORATION & ENGAGEMENT

Describe how your project will involve and engage others.

- Identify the partnership(s) and key stakeholders with local organizations or community groups and demonstrate that the project has been approved by the service partners.
- Explain how chapter members will participate in executing the project.
- Explain how alumni will be involved to ensure completion of the project.
- Describe how you will promote the project and involve any members of the community.

PROJECT FEASIBILITY

Explain how your project is realistic and achievable within the given timeframe.

- Outline your project plan, including key steps and a timeline.
- Provide a detailed budget showing how grant funds will be used.
- Identify any potential challenges and how you plan to overcome them.

Long-Term Sustainability

- If applicable, describe any plans for ongoing maintenance, funding or partnerships.
- Highlight ways the project could serve as a model for others to replicate or adapt.
