During Theta Chi's 168th Anniversary Convention, Theta Chi brothers will gather to conduct the business of the Fraternity and celebrate our success and accomplishments. The Convention will include time for alumni and collegians to reunite, network, and experience true brotherhood with members from all over North America. There are multiple casual events planned during this event including tours of the WWII Museum and a look into the world of Mardi Gras.

Theta Chi Fraternity's 41st School of Fraternity Practices (SFP) will be held in conjunction with the 168th Anniversary Convention. The SFP is an educational experience for both collegians and alumni consisting of small group discussions and keynote presentations from prominent Theta Chi brothers. The SFP curriculum is intensive and covers a wide array of topics related to chapter leadership, operations, and recruitment.

This ticket includes entrance into the 166th Anniversary Convention Awards and Recognition Banquet. This is a formal event held on Saturday evening. A pre-banquet Alumni Reception is also included provided the ticket holder is accompanied by an alumnus attendee.

Chapter Discount Codes:

Each active chapter receives waived registration fees for two collegiate men and one double occupancy hotel room at no charge. These fees and hotel costs are covered by the chapter's payment of its Annual Programming

and Benefit Fee. Each Chapter President will receive an email containing the discount code and other event-related details. The two members chosen to attend **MUST** register using the discount code to complete their registration at no cost. Members who register using one of the two Annual Programming and Benefits Fee Discount Codes do **NOT** need to book hotel accommodations as the room will be booked by the International Headquarters staff. All other Convention attendees must book their own hotel room(s).

Please note that Convention registration fees are non-refundable; however, they are transferable to another collegiate or alumnus brother or colony member. Please call the International Headquarters for assistance in transferring a registration at 317-848-1856.

Hotel Reservations*:

Attendees who DO NOT use the Annual Programming and Benefits Discount Code mentioned above **are required** to book their own hotel accommodations. The Fraternity has negotiated discounted guest room rates for the host hotel, Marriott New Orleans Canal Street. Reservations must be made by July 9, 2024, to receive the \$169 per night discounted rate.
