

Online Test Administrator (TA) Certification Course for I AM

The online TA Certification Course for I AM will be available from the I AM Portal beginning Monday, January 25. This course is a yearly requirement for all educators administering I AM. The course consists of three modules and a certification quiz and will take about 90 minutes to complete. It does not need to be completed in one sitting. Once the TA completes all three modules and earns an 80% or higher on the quiz, a certificate can be downloaded and certification will be reflected in TIDE. Remember, this course is different from the online certification course for ILEARN, IREAD-3, and ISTEP+. Certification for a general education assessment will not allow TAs to administer I AM.
