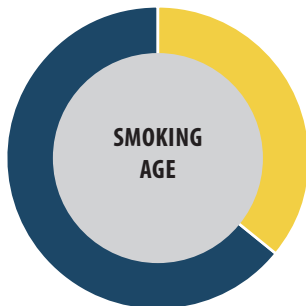




2020 SURVEY RESULTS

STATE SENATOR RODRIC BRAY

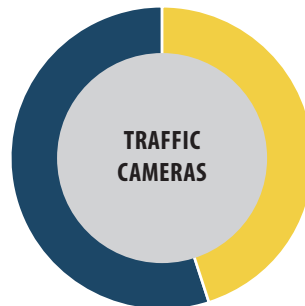

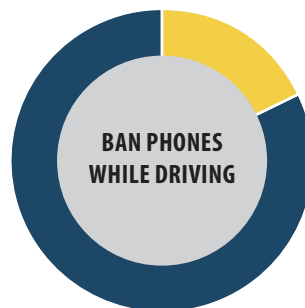
3. Do you believe cities and towns should be able to annex land without the support of a majority of the affected taxpayers?
