Pumpkin Pie Craft

Did pumpkin pie your favorite dessert during the fall season? Join in the fun making this craft!

ITEMS NEEDED

- Paper plate
- Orange Tissue Paper
- Brown Cardstock
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Stapler
- 2 Cotton Balls



STEPS

Step 1: Cut your orange tissue paper into squares.

Step 2: Cut your paper plate to resemble a pie slice.

Step 3: Put a layer of glue covering your paper plate. Cover the piece completely with orange tissue paper squares.

Step 4: Cut some squares of brown cardstock. This will be the “crust” of your pumpkin pie.

Step 5: Once your paper plate is covered with orange tissue paper, staple the squares of brown cardstock along the edge where the piecrust would be.

Step 6: Finish your pumpkin pie by gluing two cotton balls in the center of your pie slice (because every slice of pumpkin pie needs whipped cream!)
