SUBJECT: Indiana Senate Bill 1

The White House Offices of Domestic Policy and Intergovernmental Affairs strongly supports Senator Chris Garten’s (R-Charlestown) Indiana Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) as it aligns with several key priorities in President Trump’s transformational Working Families Tax Cut Act. SB 1 advances key federal priorities by strengthening accountability, reducing waste, fraud, and abuse, and ensuring public benefits are reserved for America’s truly needy and not illegal immigrants.

This bill codifies major federal reforms by aligning SNAP and Medicaid eligibility with federal law, increasing verifications, closing loopholes that undermine program integrity, and reinforcing work requirements. SB 1 also responsibly administers federal investments in the Rural Health Transformation Fund through oversight and reporting. SB 1 demonstrates Indiana’s leadership in partnering with the Administration to protect taxpayers, support working families, and restore public trust in our systems.
