This letter is meant to convey our great satisfaction with the work performed by Pauly Jail Building Company on the most recent job that we completed with their company. We were the architectural firm responsible for the design of the \$21M New Castle Correctional Facility for the Indiana Department of Correction and the GEO group. The project consisted of two buildings, each containing 128 double bunked maximum security precast cells divided into 4 dayrooms. Each dayroom was two-tier, and was directly adjacent to an outdoor recreation space, with a single control room in the hub.

This project was delivered by the Design/Build process. Pauly Jail was instrumental in helping our team win the project with their aggressive pricing and by providing the quality of product the owners desired.
