Since 2014, State Sen. Rick Niemeyer has represented Senate District 6, which includes Benton and Newton counties and the southern half of Lake County. Before his election to the Indiana State Senate, Niemeyer served in the Indiana House of Representatives.


Niemeyer is the Ranking Member of the Senate Committees on Environmental Affairs and Local Government as well as member of the Senate Committees on Homeland Security and Transportation; and Veterans Affairs and the Military.

He attended Indiana State University in Terre Haute, Indiana.

Outside the Senate, Niemeyer is the owner and operator of Lowell Livestock Auction, managing broker of Niemeyer Realty and the owner and auctioneer of Niemeyer Auction Service. He is also the president of the Lake County Community Services and a member of St. John United Church of Christ.

Niemeyer's civic involvement goes beyond his service in the General Assembly. He is a former township trustee and assessor for West Creek Township, Lake County councilman from the Seventh District, chair of the Lake County Solid Waste Board, and member of the Lake County Planning Commission and Drainage Board Advisory Committee. He is also a former member of the Tri-Creek Ambulance Service Agency.
