



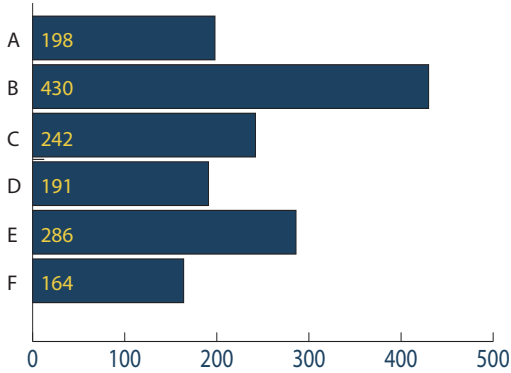

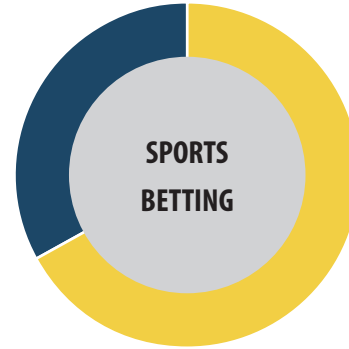
1. When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

- F) Other



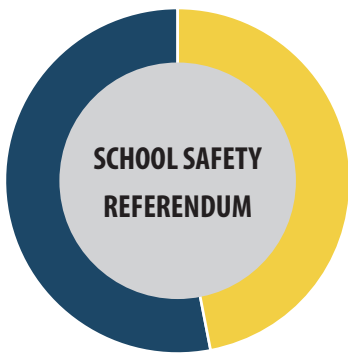
2. Do you support or oppose legalizing sports betting in Indiana?

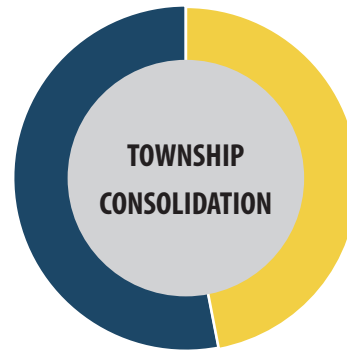
3. Do you support or oppose giving schools the ability to propose property-tax referendums specifically to pay for school safety improvements?

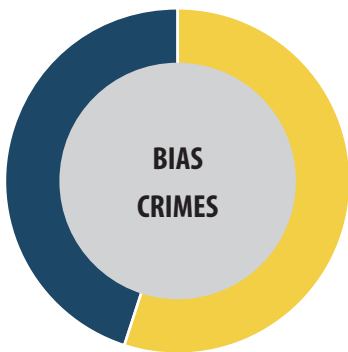
4. Do you support or oppose requiring townships with fewer than 1,000 residents to consolidate in order to make local government more efficient?

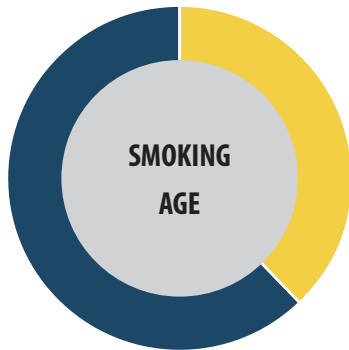

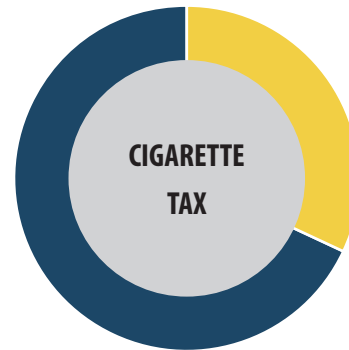
- 6.** The minimum legal age to buy cigarettes in Indiana is currently 18. Do you support or oppose raising the smoking age to 21?
