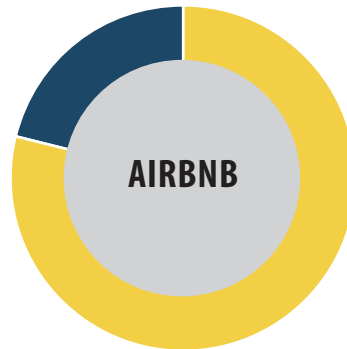
- 3.** Indiana currently charges a fee to get a handgun permit. Do you support or oppose making the permit free?

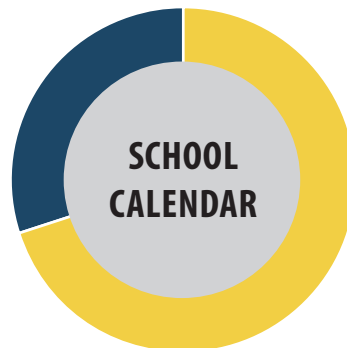
- 5.** Hoosiers currently must register about a month before Election Day in order to vote. Should the law be changed so you can both register and vote on Election Day?

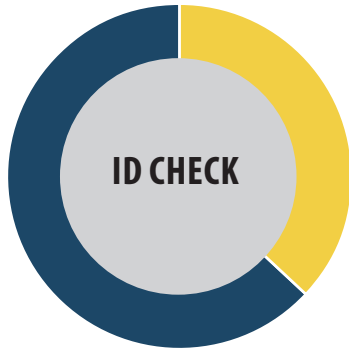
