Recycled Paper Pumpkins

SUPPLIES

- toilet paper roll
- recycled paper (computer, construction, magazine)
- scissors
- ruler
- tape or glue

OPTIONAL

- stick for pumpkin stem
- crayons, markers, colored pencils, glitter, etc.

DIRECTIONS

1. Cut out strips about 1-inch wide and 8-inches long from your recycled paper
2. If desired, color and decorate strips of paper
3. Using tape or glue, attach each end of the strip of paper into each end of the toilet paper tube
4. Repeat step 3 until your strips cover the circumference of your toilet paper tube
5. Using glue or tape, attach the stick into the center of the toilet paper tube to create the stem

Supplies

- SCISSORS
- OLD KNIT SOCK OR SWEATER SLEEVE
- FABRIC GLUE OR IRON ON SEAM TAPE



DIY Knit Mug Cozy

Instructions

1. MEASURE AROUND YOUR TRAVEL MUG WHERE YOU WANT THE COZY TO COVER
2. ADD 1 INCH TO THAT MEASUREMENT
3. CUT THE TOP SECTION OF THE SOCK OR SWEATER SLEEVE TO FIT THE MEASUREMENT
4. TURN THE SOCK INSIDE OUT AND FOLD DOWN 1 INCH OF THE CUT EDGE
5. SECURE SEAM BY GLUING OR IRONING WITH SEAM TAPE

FOLD RIGHT SIDE OUT AND SLIP ONTO YOUR MUG

Mug with Handle



- CUT A SLIT IN THE SOCK
- TRIM AWAY FRAYED EDGES
- APPLY THIN LAYER OF FABRIC GLUE TO PREVENT FUTURE FRAYING

SEW ON DECORATIVE BUTTON IF DESIRED. WASH AND DRY AS NEEDED.

HARRY POTTER BUTTERBEER RECIPE

Ingredients

1 cup brown sugar
2 tablespoons water
6 tablespoons salt
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon cider vinegar
3/4 cup heavy cream divided
1/2 teaspoon rum extract
4 bottles (12 oz.) cream soda

Instructions

1. In a small sauce pan over medium heat, combine brown sugar and water
2. Bring to a gentle boil and cook, stirring often, until the mixture reads 240° on a candy thermometer
3. Stir in butter, salt, vinegar, and 1/4 heavy cream. Set aside to cool.
4. Once cooled, stir in rum extract
5. In a medium bowl, combine 2 tablespoons of the brown sugar mixture and the remaining 1/2 cup of heavy cream.
6. Beat with electric mixer until thickened, but not whipped - about 2-3 minutes
7. Divide the brown sugar mixture between 4 tall glasses.
8. Add 1/4 cup of cream soda to each glass, then stir to combine
9. Fill each glass nearly full with additional cream soda
10. Spoon whipped topping over each glass
