Additional faculty and Academy leaders assist with abstract judging and the judging of live presentations on Research Day. The committee has been active in its email group and on several Zoom calls during the planning stages for 2023's event. The 2023 IAFP Research Day took place on Thursday, May 18 at the Ritz Charles event center in Carmel, with about 100 family medicine residents, residency program faculty, practicing FPs, and ancillary staff in attendance. For this event, we received an unprecedented total of 62 abstracts from 11 residency programs across the state. This continues the recent trend of submitted abstract numbers increasing yearly. For the first time this year, the event featured two concurrent tracks of presentations - one for Performance Improvement/Original Research and one for Case Presentations. In addition to the usual mixture of original research presentations, case presentations, and posters, the event featured the third annual Leadership Development Seminar that was planned and supported by leaders from the IAFP Foundation including Jason Marker, MD, and our committee chair, Jerry Morris, MD. We plan to continue the Leadership Development Seminar at future Research Days. \$1,800 in prize money was distributed at the end of the day. In the coming months the Committee will plan 2024's event. With the necessary adjustments, we will plan to continue with the dual track agenda to allow more residents to present their research.
