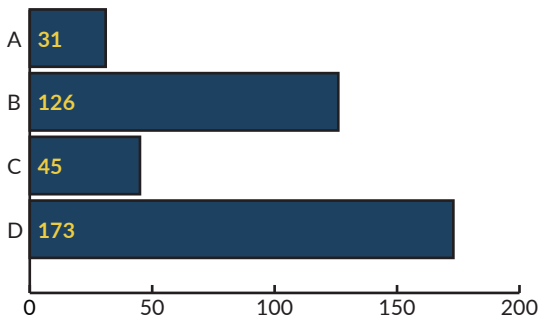

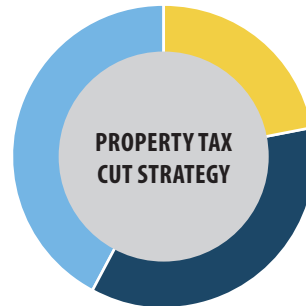
1. Which **one** of the following do you think is the fairest tax for Hoosiers to pay?

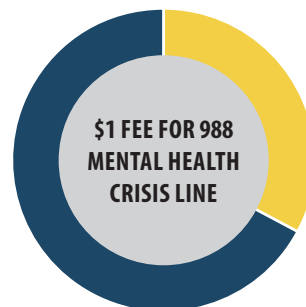

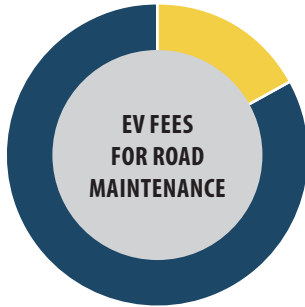

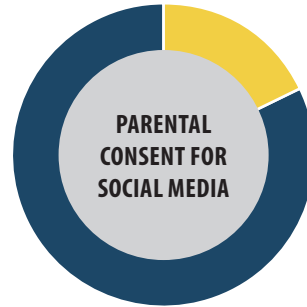

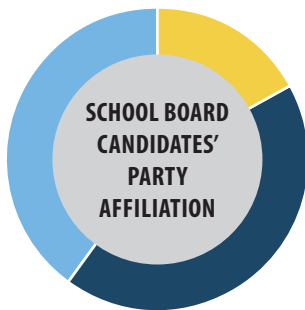

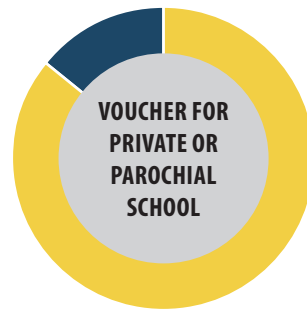

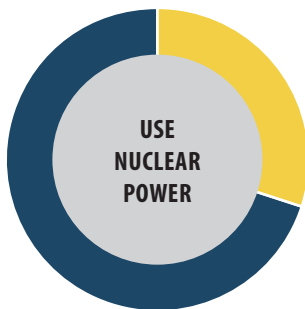
