Time Management Seminar - 2/13/17 Speaker: Keni Zenner Attendance: 30 members

Kim Novak Sponsored Event – 2/22/17 Speaker: Kim Novak Attendance: 93 members

Our chapter sponsored Kim Novak, founder and CEO of NovakTalks, to come to the Iowa State campus. Kim presented a talk on sexual assault, healthy relationships, and inter-chapter relations for anyone in the Greek Community to attend. She also came to our chapter facility, had dinner with our members, and spoke to our chapter about various risk management topics. Afterwards, she held a Q&A session that sparked great conversation with everyone present.

## Professional Lawyer Seminar – 3/7/17 Speaker: Jonathan Shroeder Attendance: 80 students total

Our chapter invited a lawyer, Jonathan Shroeder, to come and talk to our chapter before spring break about the dangers of different spring break activities. This gave our members a quick checkup for the consequences some activities could have. We also paired up with a sorority on campus, Delta Zeta, to host Jonathan at our chapter facility. We ordered pizza and wings to enjoy while listening to the presentation; this was followed by an engaging Q&A session to conclude the event.

TED Talk Seminar - 9/11/17 Speaker: AJ Hanus, Ron Finely (video) Attendance: 19 members

Our chapter hosted an in-house TED Talk seminar on September 11<sup>th</sup>. This consisted of getting together, watching the talk, *A Guerilla Gardener in South Central LA* by Ron Finely, and having discussion over what it means to be a leader. The discussion was led by AJ Hanus. This event sparked a lot of interest in being a leader in our house, on-campus, and in the community.

Mental Health Awareness Outreach – 10/26/17 Speaker: Delta Tau Delta Undergraduate Members Attendance: 18 members On-Campus Involvement: 300+ students and faculty

We hosted an on-campus outreach in our free speech zone on October 26<sup>th</sup>. At this outreach, we set up a table and had people sign handprints saying "I, (their name), lend a helping hand to mental health awareness." After signing a hand, members passed out brochures with on-campus counseling resources. This outreach was held from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.
