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5 WHEREAS, the process of filing a medical review case in Indiana involves the process of the Indiana

11 that it must first be reviewed by at least 2 physicians that are Board-certified, residents of Indiana; and
12 furthermore, expenses for obtaining such a review must be provided by the attorney pursuing the
13 possible case.
