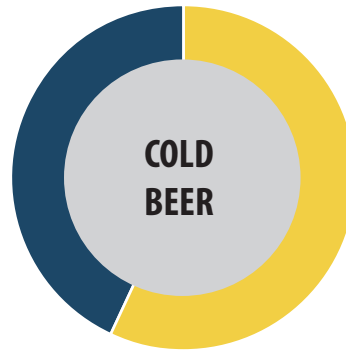
- 1.** Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?

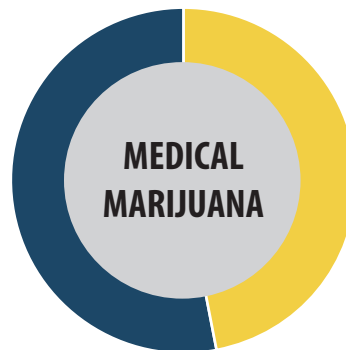
- 3.** Do you think criminals should receive longer sentences if they committed their crime because of prejudice against a specific trait of the victim such as race, religion or gender?

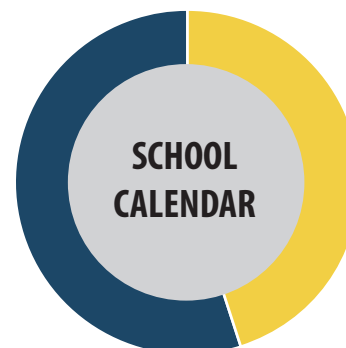
- 5.** In order to limit prescription drug abuse, should doctors be required to check a patient's prescription history before issuing a new prescription?

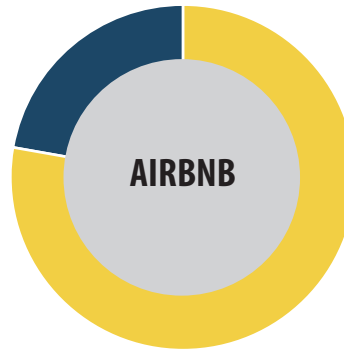
- 7.** Should a person be required to pay a fee and undergo a background check in order to get a permit to carry a handgun in public?

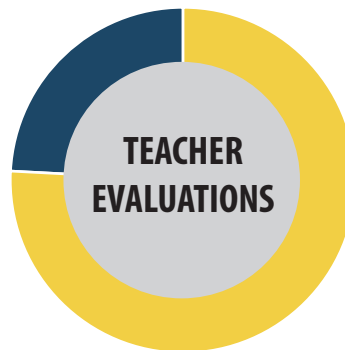
- 9.** Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health-care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?
