5 WHEREAS, the AAFP supports efforts to reduce the number of alcohol and substance impaired drivers  
6 by reducing the legal blood alcohol concentration (BAC) for drivers to 0.04 gm/dl, and

8 WHEREAS, the AMA policy supports a BAC of 0.04% as per se illegal for driving for adults and 0.02%  
9 for drivers under the age of 21, and

11 WHEREAS, the AMA report on research demonstrated substantial and consistent impairment  
12 beginning at 0.04 to 0.05 BAC, and

14 WHEREAS, one of three death on U.S. roads involve drinking and driving, therefore be it

16 RESOLVED, that the issue of reducing the number of alcohol and substance impaired drivers on  
17 Indiana highways, by reducing the blood alcohol concentration (BAC), etc., be referred to the IAFP  
18 Board of Directors for study and report to the 2019 IAFP Congress of Delegates with findings and  
19 recommendations.
