



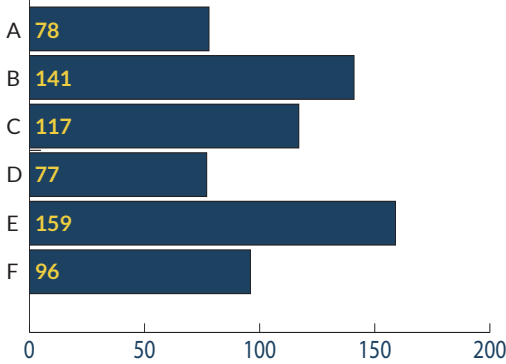

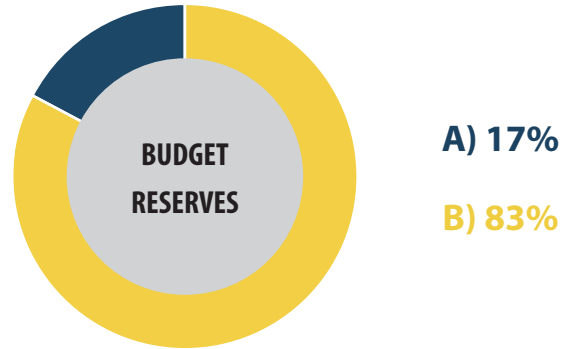
1. When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

- F) Other



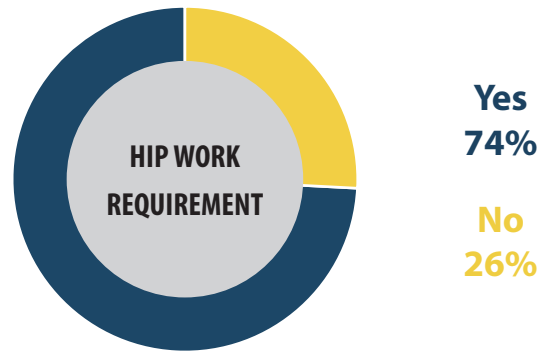

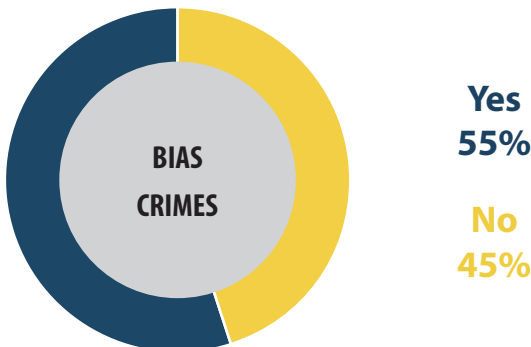
3. Do you support or oppose requiring townships with fewer than 1,000 residents to consolidate in order to make local government more efficient?

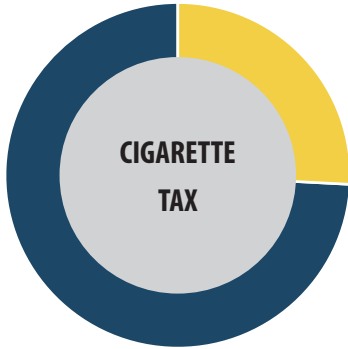
