### What if a member tests positive for COVID-19?

If a member tests positive for COVID-19, he should:

- 1.) Notify the Chapter/Colony President
- 2.) Members are strongly encouraged to notify their parents/legal guardians as well
- 3.) Follow university and local health department guidelines for reporting positive cases
- 4.) Seek medical attention and self-isolate. For more information about what to do if you become sick or when you can be around others again after you had or potentially had COVID-19, please refer to CDC guidelines:

The President should:

- 1.) Notify the Alumni Corporation President and/or Chapter/Colony Adviser
  - If the chapter has a house, the Alumni Corporation President should coordinate a thorough disinfecting of the facility, following local and CDC guidelines.
  - The Alumni Corporation President should reach out to the local health department for guidance on isolation procedures for the positive member.

- 3.) Notify all members that there has been a positive case within the chapter/colony.
  - All members should be advised to self-monitor for symptoms including fever, dry cough, and shortness of breath. If at any time these symptoms arise in a member, he should see his medical provider or seek medical attention.
  - Individual members are encouraged to notify parents/legal guardians that there has been a positive case within the chapter/colony.

# What if a member becomes COVID-19 positive?

## The member should...

Notify the Chapter/Colony President.
