Indiana State Sen. John Ruckelshaus was elected in 2016 to serve Senate District 30, which includes portions of Hamilton and Marion counties. Ruckelshaus previously served in the Indiana House of Representatives from 1990-1992 and was a deputy commissioner for the Department of Workforce Development under Gov. Mitch Daniels.

Ruckelshaus serves as Ranking Member of the Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services and as a member of the Senate Committees on Environmental Affairs and Insurance and Financial Institutions. He also serves as an Assitstant Majority Caucus Chair for the Senate Republican leadership team.

Professionally, Ruckelshaus is the director of business development at Van Ausdall and Farrar and a consultant for American Health and Wellness. He is a graduate of Indiana University and Pike High School.

Ruckelshaus resides in Indianapolis with his wife, Mary. The couple has three children.
