Indiana College Core

30 credit hour block of general education courses that is guaranteed to transfer to all Indiana public colleges and universities. This is equivalent to a full year of college credit.

Sophomore year, students have the ability to opt in to this program.

Requirements for all diplomas

8 credits in English (including speech)

6 credits in math (including Algebra I)

1 credit in personal finance

6 credits in science (including Biology I)

1 credit in computing foundations for a digital age

5 credits in social studies (including 2 in US History and 1 in Government)

1 credit in PE

1 credit in health

6 credits in a pathway

6 additional credits in electives

1 credit in prep cc

Minimum total of 42 credits

Enrollment Honors

6 social studies credits

4 world language credits

8 math credits

Grade of 'C-' or above in all courses

3.0 GPA minimum

One of the following:

4 credits in AP courses

6 college credits

SAT score of at least a 1250

Enrollment Honors Plus

Earn enrollment honors seal and earn the Indiana College Core.

Complete at least 75 hours or work based learning.

Demonstrate skill development in communication, collaboration, and work ethic.

Diplomas- Employment

Employment Honors

Complete 6 credits in a CTE pathway with a C- or higher

Complete 150 hours of work based learning

Demonstrate skill development in communication, collaboration, and work ethic.

Meet attendance requirements.

Employment Honors Plus

Earn the honors employment seal and earn the Indiana College Core.

Complete 650 work based learning hours.

Diplomas- Enlistment

Enlistment Honors

Complete and Intro to Public Service course

Achieve a score of 31 or higher on the ASVAB and complete the associated career exploration program.

Demonstrate skill development in communication, collaboration, and work ethic.

Meet attendance requirements.

Enlistment Honors Plus

Earn the enlistment honors and complete one of the following:

Achieve a score of 50 or higher on the ASVAB

Enroll in ROTC at the collegiate level

Acceptance to a service academy

Demonstrate leadership in one of the following:

Completion of at least 100 hours of public service

Hold a leadership role in a co/extra curricular activity

Complete 2 seasons of a team based physical sport or activity.

Graduation Pathways

1. Earn a high school diploma
2. Be involved in a club, sport, or have a job.
3. Show post secondary readiness
 - a. Attend C9 and complete a 1 or 2 year program and earn a C- or higher.
 - b. Complete a pathway at Indian Creek high school and earn a C- or higher
 - c. Meet SAT Benchmark scores EBRW 480 Math 530
