

BUDGET SURPLUS


- A) Return money directly to taxpayers through a one-time payment

- D) Permanently reduce taxes




3. How would you rate access to mental health care in your community?

ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH CARE




5. Indiana law currently allows counties to opt in to postelection audits that check the accuracy of voting results. Should Indiana *require* counties to participate in these post-election audits?




2. Which type of tax cut do you think would most benefit Hoosiers?
