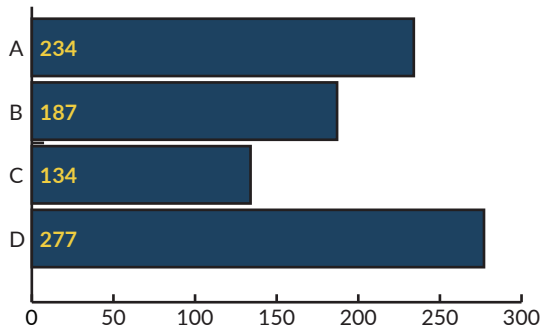

BUDGET SURPLUS

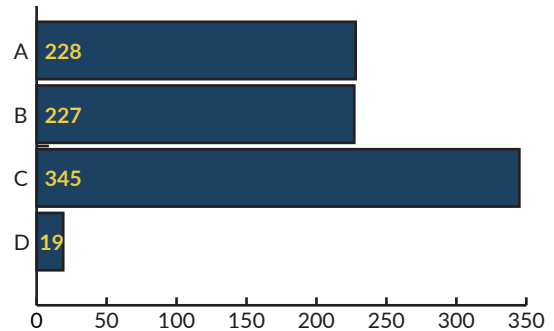
- A) Return money directly to taxpayers through a one-time payment

TAX CUT

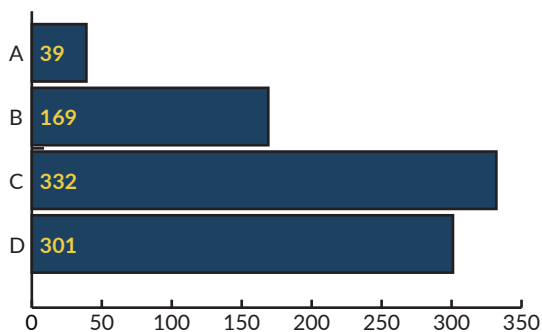
- A) Cutting the income tax

- D) Cutting property taxes on business equipment



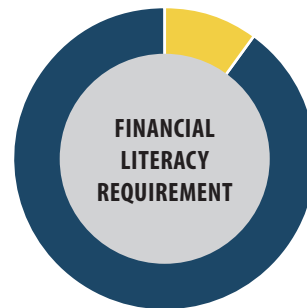
3. How would you rate access to mental health care in your community?
