Article III, Section 1d of the Fraternity Constitution

d. Except for professional, class, honorary, and social fraternities designated by the Arch Chapter, he must not previously have been a an initiated member of another national social college fraternity unless such candidate possesses a signed release from the headquarters of his prior organization.

Article IX, Section 6 of the Fraternity Constitution

Section 6: The Pledge Pin Pledge Badge

The Pledge Pin Pledge Badge shall be of such shape and with such insignia as may be determined by the Arch Chapter.

Article IX, Section 4 of the Fraternity Constitution

The Badge of membership shall always remain the property of the member upon whom the Badge has been conferred, but such Badge shall forever by be held by such member in trust for the benefit of the Fraternity and all of its then living members.

The intent of this batch of proposed changes is to correct simple grammatical errors and omissions which were not caught by previous Karneas*

Article III, Section 1a of the Fraternity Constitution

He must be of high ideals and firm in accepted moral principles as taught by the great religions of the world

Article III, Section 9d of the Fraternity Bylaws

d. The proposed initiate shall be of high ideals and firm in the accepted morals and principles as taught by the great religions of the world and possess those gentlemanly qualities that promote the highest type of brotherhood.

The intent of this batch of proposed changes is to remove the reference to the great religions of the world in membership eligibility requirements

Article III, Section 2f of the Fraternity Bylaws (new addition)

F. In situations where an undergraduate, post-graduate, or professional student of an institution where no chapter is located is desirous of membership, the individual can be considered for candidacy at an electing chapter of reasonable distance from the student, provided the individual has the prior approval of the Arch Chapter and all other gualifications for initiation are met.

The intent of this batch of proposed changes is provide for the initiation of qualified men at colleges and universities where there is not presently a chapter of Delta Tau Delta
