



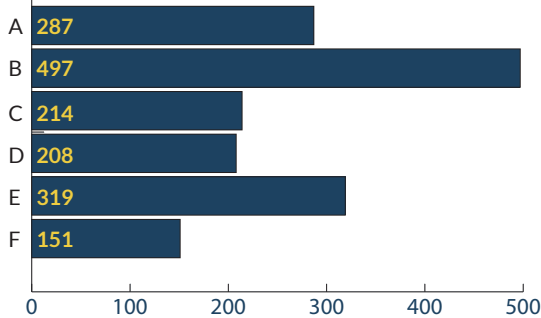

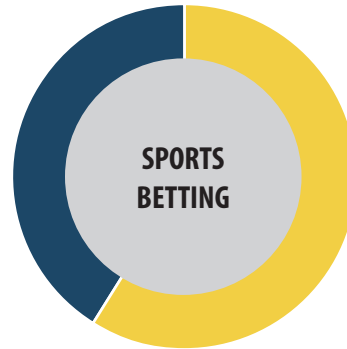
**1.** When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

- F) Other



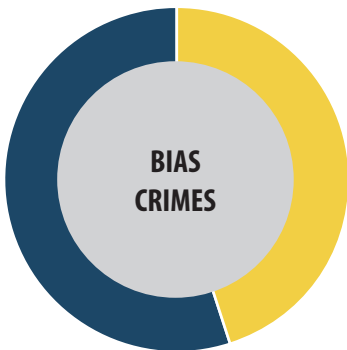
**2.** Do you support or oppose legalizing sports betting in Indiana?

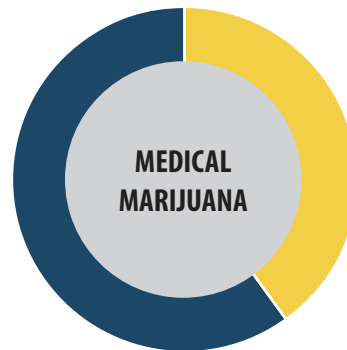

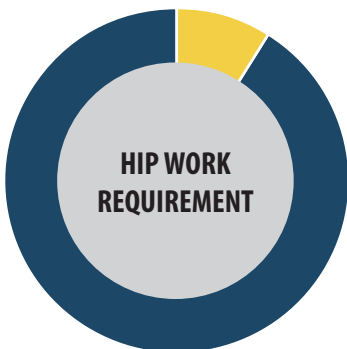
**4.** Should Indiana legalize marijuana for medical use even though it is still federally illegal and cannot be prescribed by a doctor or dispensed at a pharmacy?

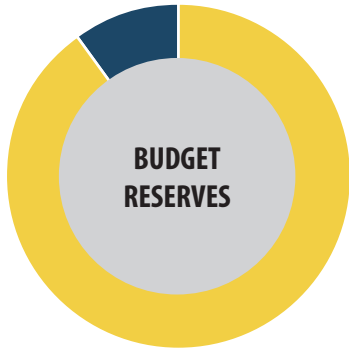

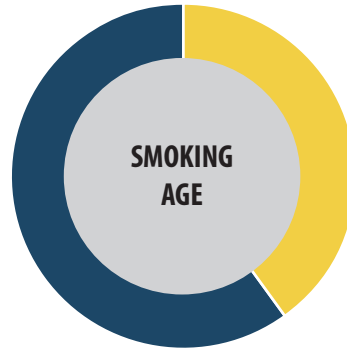

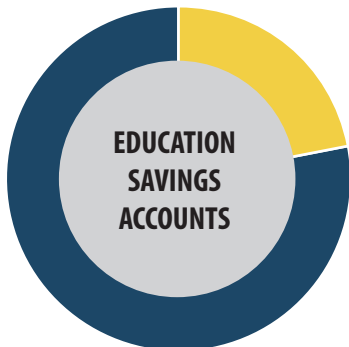

**7.** The minimum legal age to buy cigarettes in Indiana is currently 18. Do you support or oppose raising the smoking age to 21?



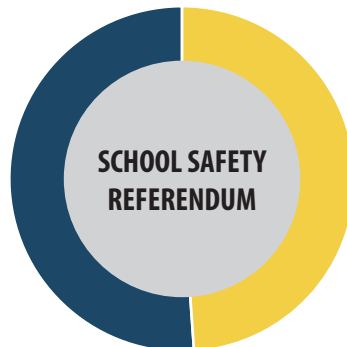
**Support 60%**
