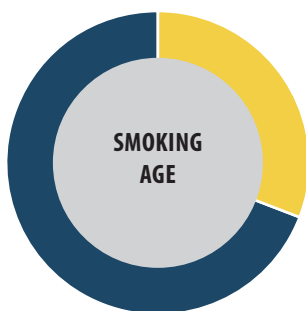

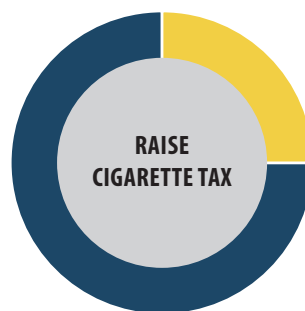
STATE SENATOR VANETA BECKER

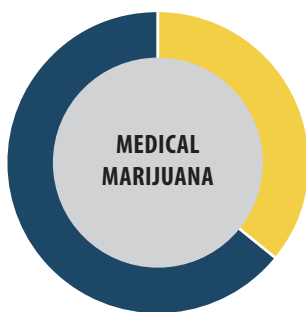

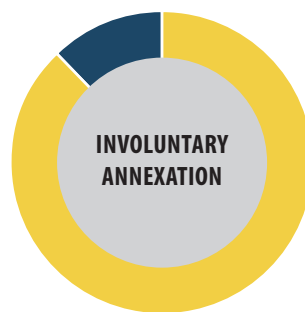

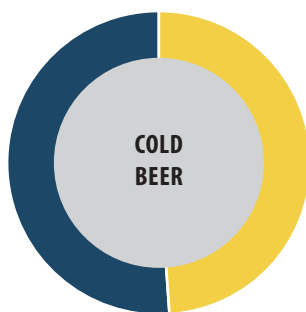

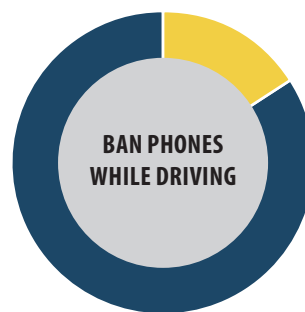

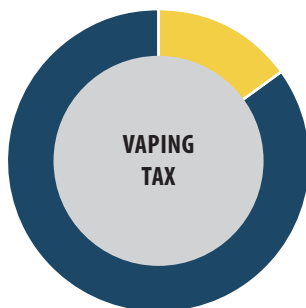

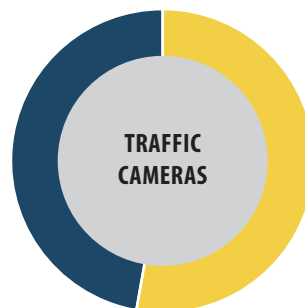
- 7.** Should Indiana place a tax on vaping products similar to the tax that is currently placed on cigarettes?
