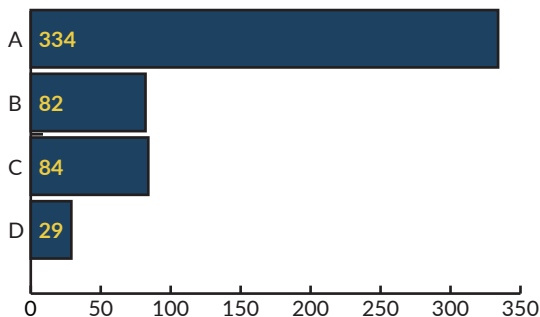

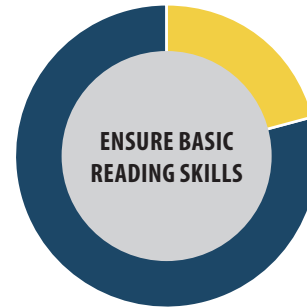

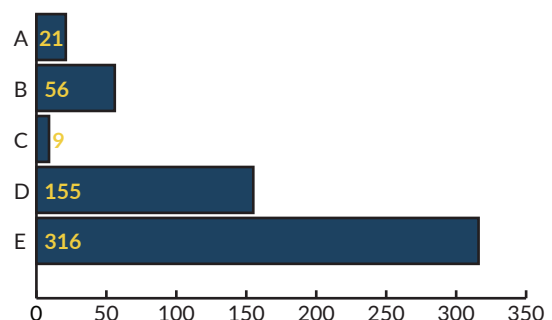

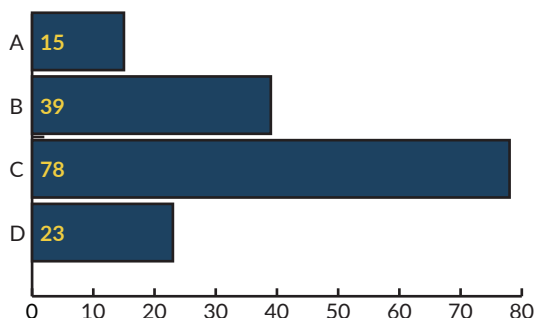

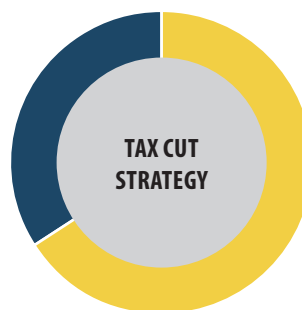

6. Do you think it would be better for Indiana to **A)** make a large cut to one type of tax or **B)** make smaller cuts to multiple taxes?



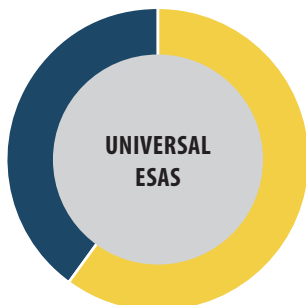
7. Should Indiana change our high school diploma requirements so students can do more on-the-job learning and spend less time in a classroom?



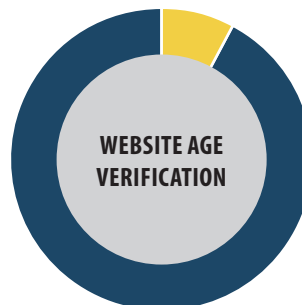
8. Should Indiana require all high school students to participate in a job experience before they graduate?

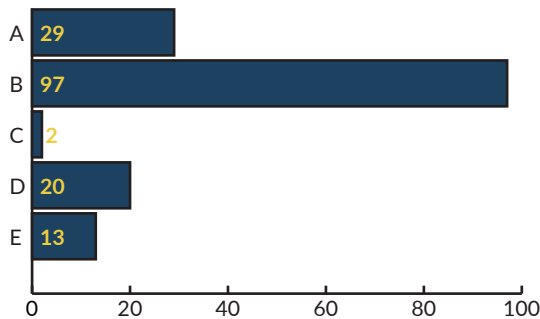

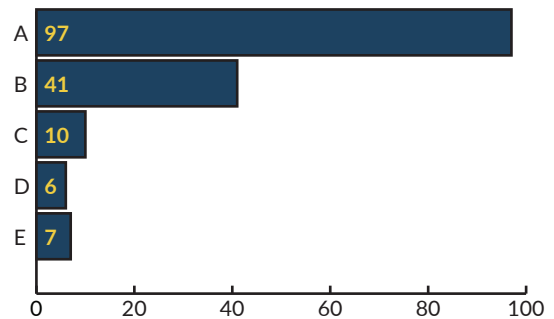

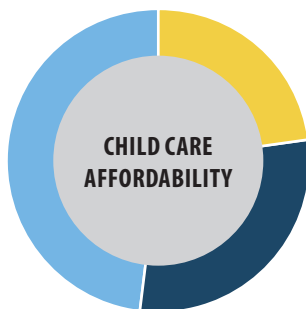
- 12.** How would you rate the reliability of high-speed internet where you live?

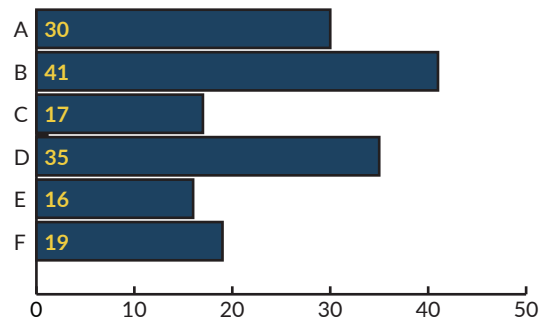
