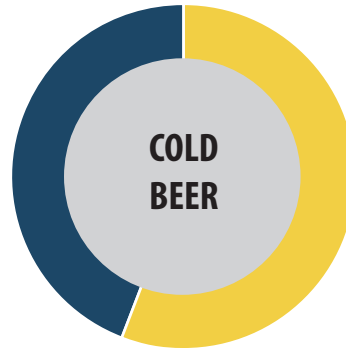
- 1.** Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?

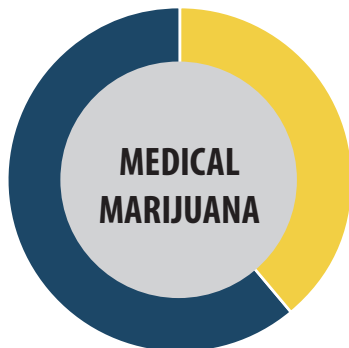

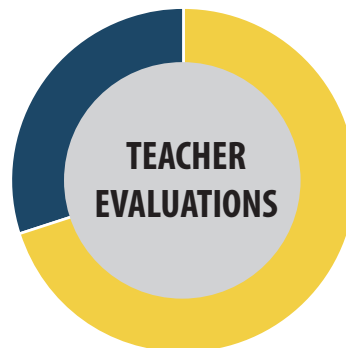

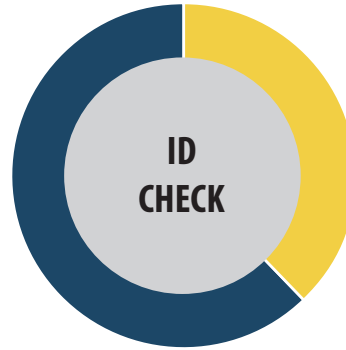

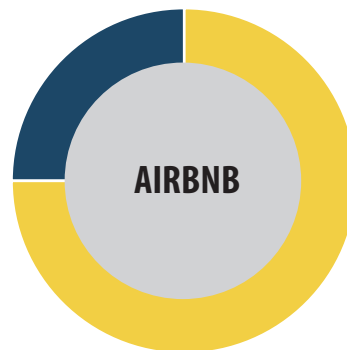
- 9.** Indiana currently charges a fee to get a handgun permit. Do you support or oppose making the permit free?

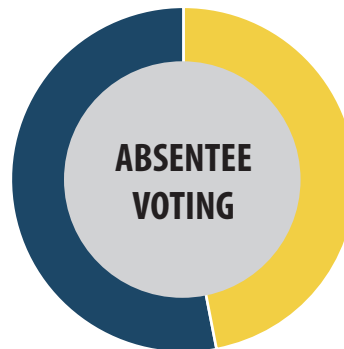

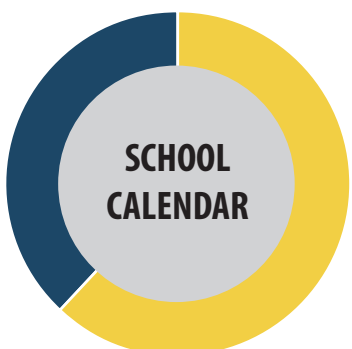

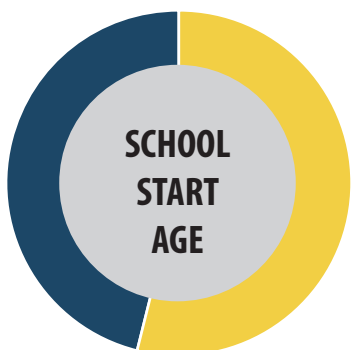
