




 - F) Other




3 Do you support or oppose legalizing sports betting in Indiana?




Do you support or oppose giving parents of special-needs children the option to use state educational funding for services such as private-school tuition and developmental therapy?









Do you support or oppose giving schools the ability to propose property-tax referendums specifically to pay for school safety improvements?




Do you support or oppose requiring every Indiana school to conduct active-shooter safety drills?
