As required in our Judicial Board guidelines, any member who is charged with violating the Delta Upsilon Constitution and Bylaws or Chapter policies is entitled to the following:

1. A written notice, at least 72 hours prior to a hearing, of the rules or regulations the members has been accused of violating.
2. A written copy of the charge being brought.
3. A written notice of the time, date and location of the hearing.
4. The right to be accompanied by an advisor of your choice during the judicial hearing.
5. The right to present witnesses to offer testimony on one's behalf (All witnesses must be affiliated with Delta Upsilon).
6. The right to an expeditious hearing.
7. The right to refuse to answer questions of an incriminating nature.
8. The name(s) of the person(s), or group filing the charges.
9. The right to an appeal.

Since you are the <complainant/defendant> in this matter, it is important that you attend the hearing. You may also contact any witness (*DU brothers only*) and inform them of the hearing.
