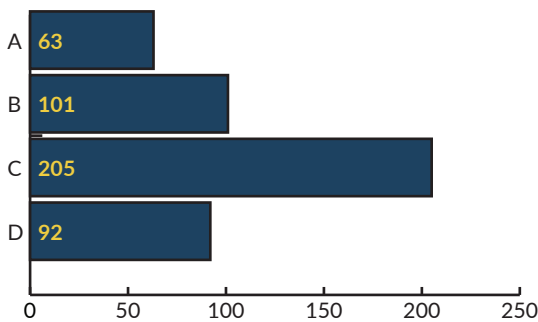

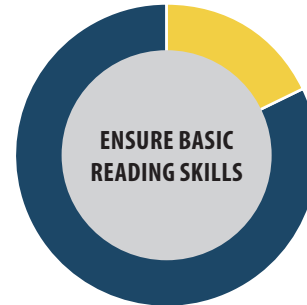

D) Sales tax



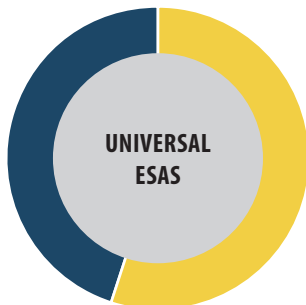
2. Should Indiana law require students to be held back if they can't demonstrate basic reading skills by the end of third grade?

4. If a prosecutor categorically refuses to charge certain crimes, should the state give a special prosecutor the authority to enforce Indiana's laws in that county?



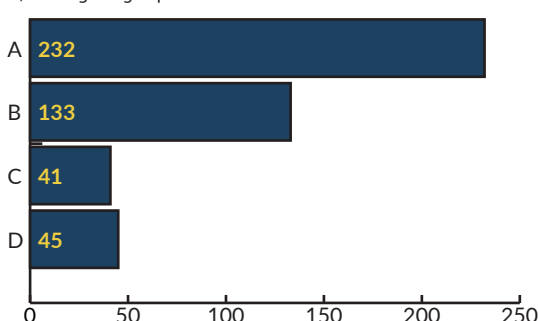

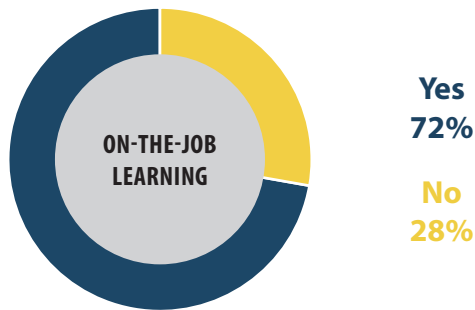

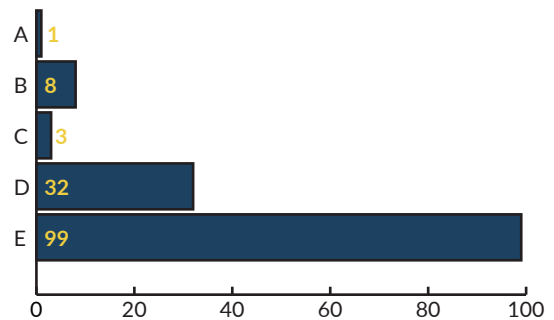
- 6.** Should Indiana change our high school diploma requirements so students can do more on-the-job learning and spend less time in a classroom?
