BIOGRAPHY

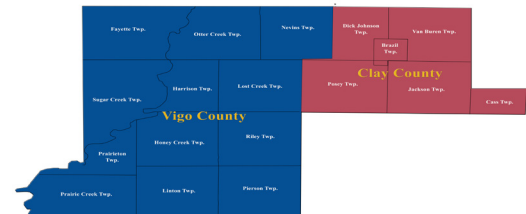
Elected to the Senate in 2014, Indiana State Sen. Jon Ford has represented Hoosiers in Western Indiana at the Statehouse for three years. As a state senator, Ford represents Senate District 38, which includes all of Vigo County and the northern part of Clay County.

Ford is a member of five Senate Committees: Elections, Family and Children Services, Homeland Security and Transportation, Public Policy, and Veterans Affairs and the Military. Ford has also served as the Chairman of the Indiana Arts Commission.

Professionally, he is the vice president of business development at Employee First Network, a nationwide independent food service management company. He served as co-owner and president of All State Mfg., a manufacturing company, for 17 years, and is a former board member of the Indiana Manufacturer's Association. He also holds a bachelor's degree from Misericordia University in business administration and marketing.

Ford's civic involvement goes beyond his service in the General Assembly. He is a former member of several organizations, including the Wabash Valley Community Foundation, Vigo County Youth Soccer, Leadership Wabash Valley, March of Dimes of Wabash Valley and the Swope Art Museum.

Ford and his wife, Kirsten, reside in Terre Haute with their two sons.
